4. FIRST AID MEASURES

In Case of Inhalation

- Remove the victim from the contamination immediately to fresh air.
- Artificial respiration and/or oxygen if necessary.

In Case of Skin Contact

- Remove product from skin with dry cloth or towel, and wash exposed area with clean water.

In Case of Eye Contact

- Wash out immediately with fresh running water.
- Seek medical attention.

In Case of Ingestion

- Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Transport to a hospital immediately.

In either case, if an abnormality is urged to consult a doctor.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguish Media

- Dry chemical powder, carbon dioxide, alcohol-resistant foam or water should be used for small fires.
- For a large scale of blaze, it may be effective to use foam extinguishers to block air.

Unsuitable extinguishing media

- Do not use spurted water to extinguish.

Specific Hazards during Fire

- Flammable liquid. Hazardous toxic and irritating fumes or smoke may be emitted.
- Vapors may travel considerable distance to ignition source and flash back.

Special Fire Fighting procedures

- Move containers from fire area if it can be done without risk, if not possible, apply water from a safe distance to cool and protect surrounding area.
- Contain the source of flames at the center of the fire.
- Water streams may spread the blaze.
- Use water spray to cool nearby structures exposed to fire.
- Do not allow run-off from fire fighting to enter drains or water courses.

Protection for Fire-fighter

- Firemen should wear normal protective equipment.
 - Use a self-contained breathing apparatus and also a protective suit.
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6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal Precautions

- Evacuate personnel to a safe area.
- Remove all sources of ignition.
- Be careful to flashback in fire.
- Ensure adequate ventilation.
- Wear protective gloves and safety goggles.

Environmental Precautions

- Attention should be given not to cause damage to the environment by allowing of spillage to rivers.
- Do not allow surface water to enter drains and sewers as this will create a potential explosive hazard. If this occurs inform local authorities immediately.

Methods of Cleaning or Taking up

- Take up spilled material with ashes or other adsorbents and put all wastes in a plastic bag for disposal and seal it tightly.
- Large spills, dike the spilled material to stop the flow of material.
- Collect spillage into container by sweeping, shoveling, etc. avoiding creation of dust. (In case of the melt, do after solidifying.)
- Dispose as hazardous waste.

Prevention of second accident

- Remove nearby sources of ignition and prepare extinguishing media.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling

- Provide sufficient air exchange and/or exhaust in work rooms.
- Do not leak, overflow, or splash.
- Keep container tightly closed.
- Wear personal protective equipment.
- Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing.
- Wash hands before breaks and immediately after handling the product.
- Handle material with suitable protection away from source of heat or ignition and use non-sparking type tools.

Storage

- Store in a dark, cool place and tightly closed.
- Keep container tightly closed, and store in refrigerator.
- Store away from sunlight in well-ventilated dry place.
- Protect against heat.
- Keep away from : strong acids, strong bases and oxidising compounds.
